Safeguarding

St Andrew's College (SAC) follows all procedures set out in the St Andrew's Healthcare (SAH) Safeguarding of Vulnerable Adults and Children policy.

Pertinent elements covered by SAH Safeguarding policy:

- Allegations against staff
- Safeguarding procedures and processes
- CAMHS Safeguarding Reporting Guidance
- Safeguarding children
- Wider issues:
 - Prevent
 - Patient to patient safeguarding concerns
 - Support for service users and carers
 - Freedom to speak up guardians and SafeCall

Addendum to St Andrew's Healthcare Safeguarding Vulnerable Adults and Children policy

In addition to SAH Safeguarding policy, SAC ensures the following:

- There will be a Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) for the College who will be Level 4 trained
- The DSL will attend CAMHS and hospital wide Safeguarding meetings and will be the point of contact within the College
- The DSL will provide yearly training to the College Governors on KCSIE updates
- The DSL will deliver yearly training on KCSIE updates to all college staff during a Teacher Training Day
- All staff will complete online Safeguarding courses annually, in addition to in-house Level 3 Safeguarding training every three years
- The DSL and Headteacher will ensure all enhanced DBS information for college staff is stored on the Single Central Register
- The Headteacher will be responsible for Section 128 checks and all prohibition from teaching checks prior to appointing new staff
- All staff to be aware that the SAH filtering and monitoring system, although more robust than any school setting, is not 100% effective, so staff will observe all learners when using college technology
